Background

The Florence range was introduced to offer exciting and youthful wines that can be enjoyed regularly. The range was named after the only granddaughter of Marianne & Fons Aaldering, Florence. From the Latin name Florentius or the feminine form Florentia, which also means "prosperous" and "to blossom".

Tasting Notes

Pale straw in colour.

A medley of tropical fruit, melon and stone fruit notes delights the nose.

The medium bodied palate is supported by stone fruit and guava following through from the nose and lending a fine texture to the mid palate.

A flinty, crushed seashell back palate intertwines well with the zesty acidity that lends freshness and length to this delightful Chenin Blanc.

Vintage Report

The warmer 2022 growth season led to higher acidities and higher flavour levels in the wines. The wine was fermented in stainless steel tanks and left on the lees for 10 months to add mouthfeel and complexity.

Aging Potential

Enjoy right now or age up to 5 years after vintage. Bottled with a handy screwcap, in order to preserve maximum flavours. Ideal serving temperature between 8-10°C.

Food Matches

Enjoy this wine with pork or poultry Asian sweet and sour dishes, sushi and sashimi.
